Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of the school shall be restricted to 12. Any further increase shall require prior approval of the Board subject to compliance with affiliation bye laws and availability of rooms of 500 sq. ft. dimension.
2	The school has uploaded the revised Land Certificate dt. 05/11/2022 on the Mandatory Public Disclosure. The same certificate be uploaded on the SARAS portal.
3	The Special Educator appointed earlier by the school did not have the necessary qualifications. The school has appointed Shri. Vageesha A.H. as a Special Educator and the appointment letter with his qualifications is uploaded on the School's website. The same documents should be uploaded on the SARAS portal as compliance.
4	The campus of the school is not maintained as it is covered with weeds. Therefore, the school should cordon the area unutilized so that students don't have access to that area. The area being utilized should be maintained by removing the weeds and submit the compliance on SARAS portal within 3 months.
5	The school should fix doors for the girls urinals and submit the compliance on the SARAS portal within 3 months with videography.
6	A carpet has been laid on the entry through the collapsible grill gate which is obstructing the free movement of Wheel Chairs. The school shall remove the grill gate and carpet and submit compliance on SARAS portal within 3 months with videography.
7	There are many books kept on the floor and table which are not entered in the accession register. The books are not arranged subject wise and not stacked properly on racks. The school shall upgrade the library as per SoP issued by the Board within 3months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
8	The school should ensure training of teachers with CoE Bengaluru and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every

month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
